

European digital competence recognition scheme

WHAT?

Recognition of teachers' digital competencies at B2 level based on:

- eTwinning projects
- completion of a series of free online courses '[Unlocking the power of teachers' digital competencies](#)'

The B2 proficiency level corresponds with the learning outcomes of the European Digital Competence Framework for Educators (DigCompEdu) and the SELFIE for Teachers self-assessment tool.

WHY?

- Make your digital teaching skills visible and valued
- Further your professional development with European-level recognition
- Increase your confidence in using digital tools for teaching and learning
- Gain a valuable addition to your CV or portfolio
- Join a growing community of educators using digital tools throughout Europe

HOW?

- Complete the SELFIE for Teachers self-assessment tool to explore and get tips on how you are currently using digital technologies in your practice
- Follow the free online courses and get certificates of completion
- Showcase exceptional performance in the use of technology and pedagogical approaches as part of the eTwinning National Quality Label
- Submit evidence of your training and projects to receive a certificate recognising your digital competencies
- The recognition process follows a two-year implementation timeline

Key dates and deadlines

eTwinning teachers pursuing the [European recognition scheme for digital competencies](#) should keep in mind the following deadlines.

Course completion

These deadlines relate to the assignments and peer assessments for the [six courses](#) you need to complete to be eligible.

	Spring (of each year)	Autumn (of each year)
Submission of course assignments	15 April	15 October
Submission of peer assessments	15 May	15 November

Note: if you have already completed the courses within the scheme's two-year timeline, you do **not** need to resubmit assignments or peer assessments.

Submission of evidence

	Spring (of each year)	Autumn (of each year)
Deadline to submit proof of the National Quality Label and course completion	31 May	30 November

You may submit evidence in **either the spring or autumn round**, regardless of when the courses were completed, provided all requirements have been met.

Keep in mind

- Course completion and submission of evidence **are separate steps with different deadlines**.
- You may complete courses in the spring round and submit your evidence in the autumn round (or later).
- If you miss a deadline, you can still apply in the next round.
- All evidence **must be no more than two years old** at the time of submission.
